Otherwise, FEHRL members have been very busy preparing proposals for the <u>Horizon 2020</u> and <u>Infravation</u> Calls. FEHRL is also collaborating with key European transport infrastructure partners and others to integrate road infrastructure with cross/inter/multi-modality aspects. Besides, FEHRL is putting an emphasis on the exploitation and implementation of R&D&I results. To that end, FEHRL will sign a Memorandum of Understanding with key stakeholder CEDR at the already announced FEHRL 25th anniversary on 13th November at FEHRL member BRRC's premises in Sterrebeek, Belgium.
